



Instructions for Travelers

Entering from Ebola Virus Disease Quarantine Inspection Required Area

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In accordance with the 「Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act」, you are required to comply with the following measures to prevent the spread of Ebola Virus Disease.

Please fill out the distributed Health Questionnaire, Travel Record Declaration and Self-Checklist accurately. Failing to submit the documents or submitting false information will result in a sentence of up to one year of imprisonment or fine of up to 10 million won in accordance with the relevant Act.

※ If your contact address (residence) and telephone number (mobile phone) in Korea cannot be verified, you may be subject to entry restriction or deportation. If there is any change in the address (residence) or contact details in Korea after entry, please notify the relevant health center personnel* (* contact number for the relevant public health center personnel will be given when leaving the temporary residential facility.)

After receiving a passport sticker with country indication at the quarantine area and arriving at the temporary residential facility for tests or quarantine, please alert the staff that you are from an Ebola Virus Disease Quarantine Inspection Required Area.

If you have symptoms such as fever, headache, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, muscle pain, rash, or bleeding within 21 days (maximum incubation period) after entering Korea, do not visit a medical institution but call 1339 or the relevant public health center personnel for information.

※ Symptoms of Ebola Virus Disease include fever, headache, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, muscle pain, rash, and bleeding after a latent period of 2-21 days (average 8-10 days).
